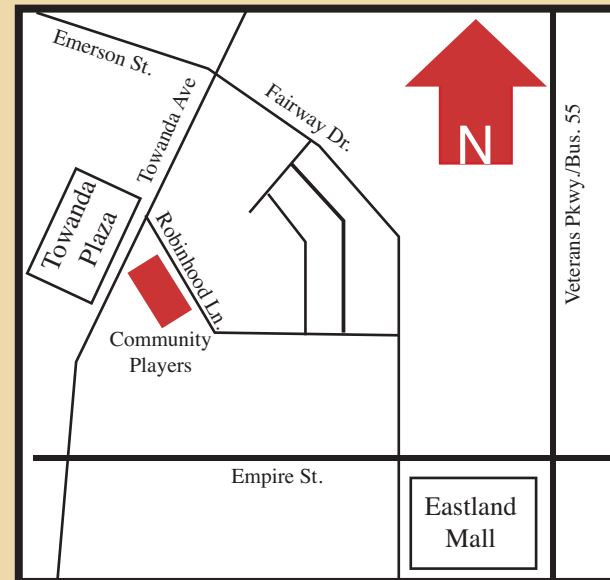


**Titanic:
